Activities:



- Go on a nature walk to look at birds, butterflies, and plants, collecting seeds and flowers from the nature trails and gardens.
- Plant a seed in a recyclable container to take home, and learn about the importance of growing new native plants.
- Make a bird feeder that will bring birds to your back yard, and learn about birds that live in the Valley.
- Make bird feed – learn about 4 ways to feed birds in your back yard
- Plant a Butterfly plant to help save nature.
- “Be a Butterfly” –an interactive lesson in which daisies will learn what it is like to go through a butterfly’s life cycle.

Activities:
